Oxygono is a non-profit non-governmental organisation registered in 2014 and headquartered in Cyprus. It works to improve the policy-making process in Cyprus and beyond in order to make it more participatory, transparent and science-based. It is made up of people from a wide range of backgrounds. It is a fully independent organisation, governed by a five-member board of directors, a ten-member executive committee and a number of advisory bodies.

The organisation does not express any specific political views. The idea and vision of Oxygono is above every individual who participates in its projects. Oxygono provides the platform for different views to be expressed. In addition to the various projects that Oxygono participates in regarding the improvement of democratic institutions, its flagship projects are the Cyprus Forum, the Cyprus Forum Cities and the Nomoplatform.



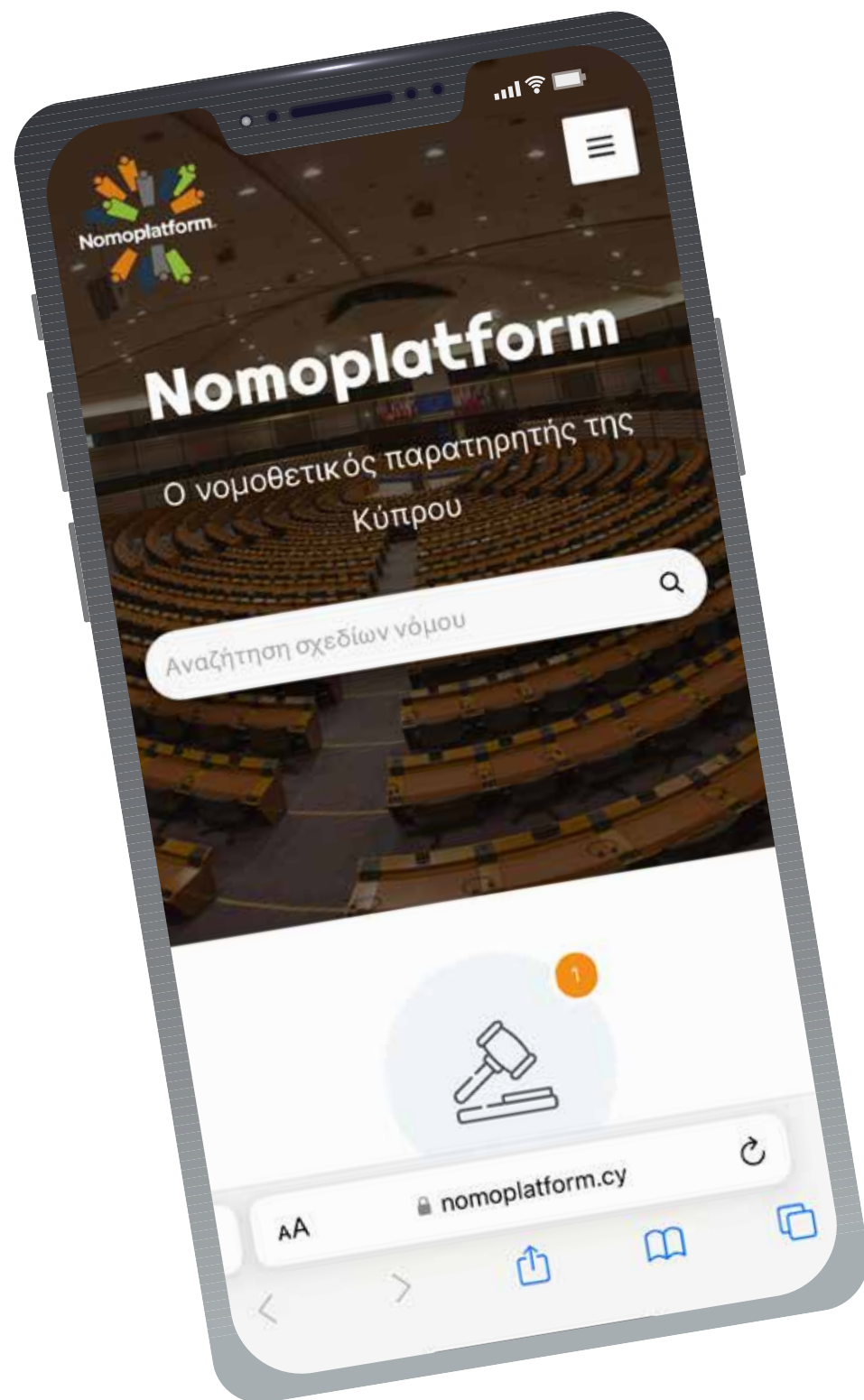
The Cyprus Forum is an independent, ambitious and not-for-profit conference, organised by Oxygono, in association with the Delphi Economic Forum.

Its objective is to become a lever and catalyst for change through discussions and debates leading to commitments, actions and ultimately outcomes. It promotes sustainable and socially responsible policies in Cyprus and the wider Eastern Mediterranean region. The Cyprus Forum brings together local and foreign political leaders, prominent figures from the public and the private sector, the media, academia and civic society to initiate dialogue, exchange ideas and find new and creative solutions to key public policy issues.



Cyprus Forum Cities is the unification of the "2040" series organised by Oxygono in a single forum, the largest local government conference in Cyprus. The aim of the Cyprus Forum Cities is, through high-level discussions, to provide the opportunity for the formation of a long-term sustainable plan for the development of the cities and rural areas of Cyprus and beyond.





Nomoplatform, the first digital parliamentary observatory in Cyprus is a politically independent initiative that aims to increase transparency within the Parliament of Cyprus. It provides the opportunity to every citizen to access the process of submission, discussion and voting of pending bills.



The Procedural Law Unit at the University of Nicosia was established in 2019 with the aim of providing scientific research on procedural law and the administration of justice in Cyprus and beyond. Each year, the unit organises an annual symposium where policymakers, academics, judges and lawyers meet and discuss policymaking and academic trends in the area of the administration of justice
