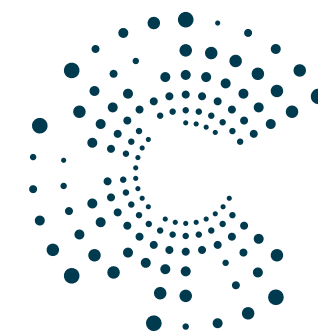

It works to improve the policy-making process in Cyprus and beyond in order to make it more participatory, transparent and science-based. It is made up of people from a wide range of backgrounds. It is a fully independent organisation, governed by a five-member board of directors, a ten-member executive committee and a number of advisory bodies.

The organisation does not express any specific political views. The idea and vision of Oxygen for Democracy is above every individual who participates in its projects. Oxygen for Democracy provides the platform for different views to be expressed. In addition to the various projects that Oxygen for Democracy participates in regarding the improvement of democratic institutions, its flagship projects are the Cyprus Forum, the Cyprus Forum Cities and the Nomoplatform.

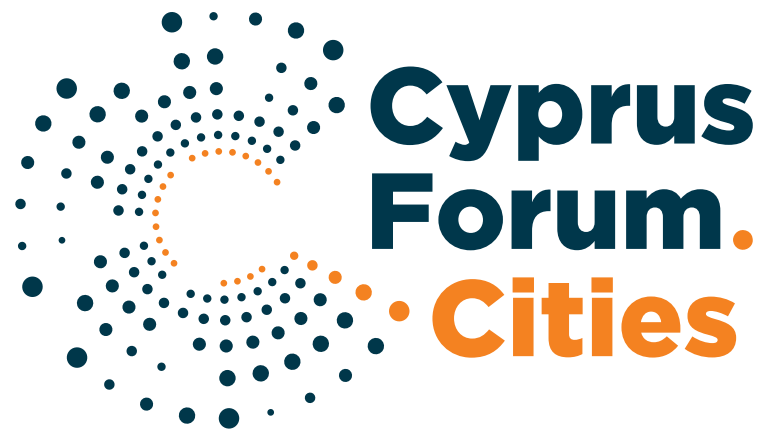


The Cyprus Forum is an independent, ambitious and not-for-profit conference, organised by Oxygen for Democracy, in association with the Delphi Economic Forum.

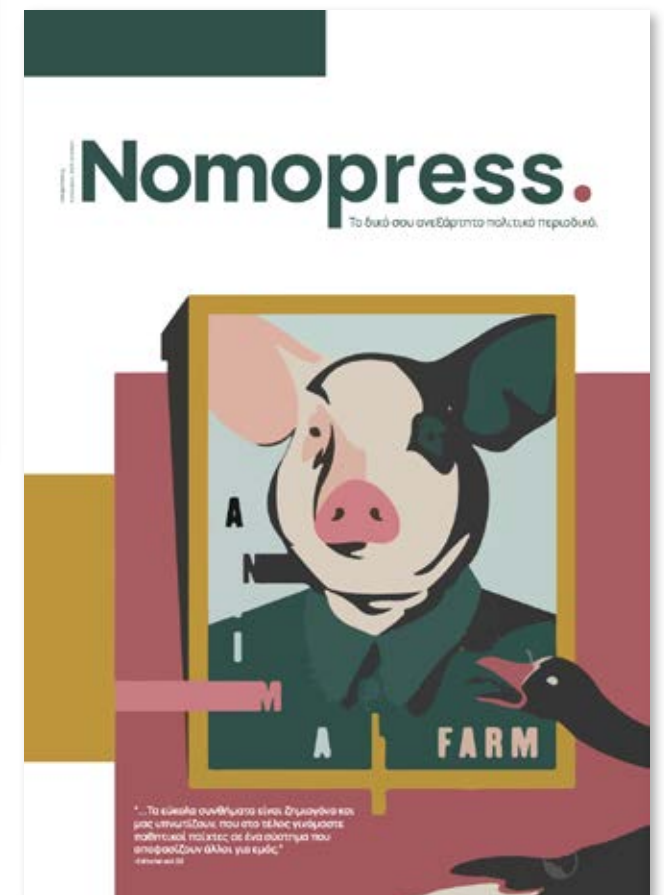
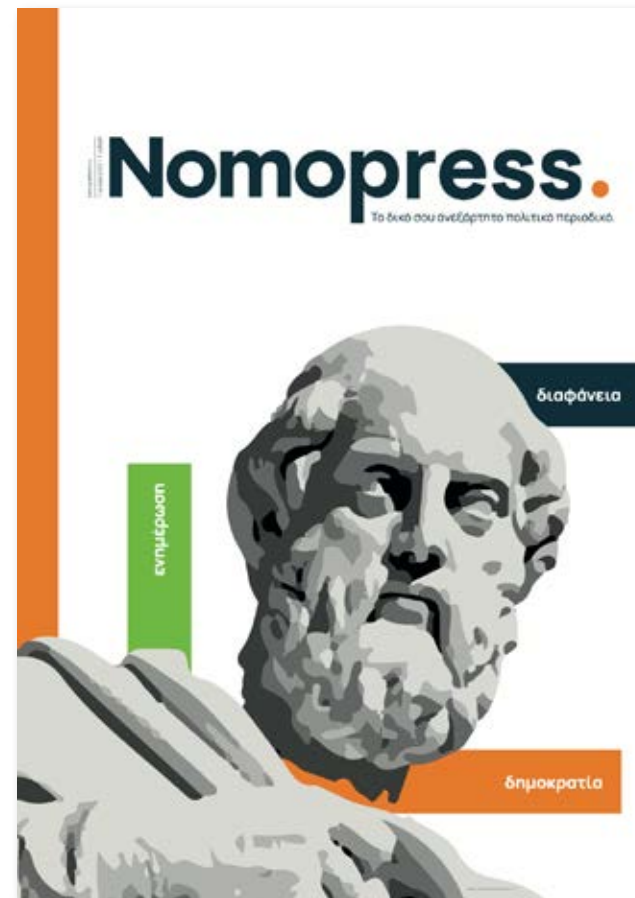
